Guest Instructor Vasyl Kanavets

Mr. Vasyl Kanevets, born in Kyiv, Ukraine, began his dancing career at the age of five with the children’s folk dance group at the Kyiv Central Place of Pioneers. His extensive dance experience led him to the State Ballet Academy of Kyiv, where he received his Professional Dancer Diploma. Subsequently, he attended the Kyiv State Institute of Culture where he completed his Ballet Masters Degree with Honours in 1985. In 1995, Mr. Kanevets moved to Canada where he continued to work as a professional dance instructor and choreographer. In addition, he has held various positions with, and is currently the Co-Artistic Director of the Vaganova Dance Society in Edmonton. From 2005 until 2016, Mr. Kanavets was the Artistic Director of the Tryzub Ukrainian Dance Ensemble. His choreography was characterized by intense, technical, and original dances with great audience appeal. Currently, Mr. Kanavets is an instructor for the Yatran Dance Academy in Edmonton, Vykroutas Ukrainian Dance School in Calgary, and Avrora Ukrainian Dancers in Fort McMurray.
